

**Jaehyuk Lee** is a South Korean saxophonist praised for his compelling musicianship and commanding stage presence. He is rapidly emerging as one of the most promising artists of his generation, distinguished by top prizes at major international competitions including the Eisenberg–Fried Concerto Competition, the Philharmonic Society of Arlington Young Artist Competition, the Vienna International Music Competition, the Mozart Competition, the London Young Musician Competition, and the Lillian Fuchs Chamber Music Competition.

Lee has appeared as a soloist at Carnegie Hall and performed with the Arlington Symphony Orchestra as a featured Arlington Young Artist. He was also selected as a soloist with the Manhattan School of Music Orchestra, further affirming his artistic distinction. In South Korea, he earned first prize and a special award at a prestigious national competition and performed with leading ensembles such as the Bucheon Philharmonic Orchestra, the Seoul Wind Orchestra, and the Korean Dito Orchestra.

Beyond the concert stage, Lee served in the Korean Army Band, performing extensively nationwide and developing a strong connection with diverse audiences through public and ceremonial performances. His international experience includes collaborations with the Manhattan School of Music Orchestra and the Arlington Symphony Orchestra, reflecting his versatility as both a soloist and ensemble musician.

Lee holds a Bachelor of Music degree from Seoul National University and a Master of Music degree from the Manhattan School of Music. He is currently pursuing the Artist Diploma at the John J. Cali School of Music at Montclair State University, where he studies under Stacy Wilson. He was recently selected to join the United States Army Band, marking a significant milestone in his professional career.

Deeply committed to music education, Lee maintains a private teaching studio in New Jersey and serves as conductor of the Amadeus Youth Wind Band, where he mentors young musicians and fosters artistic growth. He is also an Artist Ambassador for **JLV Sounds Paris**, extending his artistic presence to the international music community.

With a career spanning international competitions, orchestral collaborations, military service, and education, Jaehyuk Lee continues to captivate audiences worldwide and establish himself as a leading saxophonist of his generation.
